

Stunting Comprehensive Training and Workshop

Description

The role of pediatricians is to conduct further diagnosis with stunting and red-flag evaluations. Providing intervention using Special Medical Needs Processed Food (PKMK) if red-flags and stunting diagnoses are found. After that, the child's condition needs to be monitored together by all parties. This process involving various health workers is at the forefront of handling stunting. Therefore, pediatricians need to be equipped with competencies in the process of managing stunting patients, starting from early detection to further therapy through a referral system.

The "Stunting Comprehensive Training and Workshop" activity aims to better understand the management of stunting and tiered referrals, can be implemented according to the conditions of regional hospitals, especially each pediatrician. Moreover, participants can share experiences and strategies together to overcome the challenges of reducing stunting rates faced in

Indonesia.



Children with a history of premature birth are at risk for growth and development disorders. Proper nutrition is essential for the growth and development of premature babies. The purpose of providing nutrition to premature babies is to meet the growth rate of healthy fetuses at the same gestational age, and to produce the same body composition as healthy fetuses, including cell structure and number, concentration of tissue and blood nutrients, and developmental outcomes. Therefore, this workshop was held to prevent stunting through comprehensive early nutritional management in premature babies.
